Get Trained on Aerial Lifts. This training will provide both classroom and hands-on operations training for Scissor and Boom lifts. Upon successful completion students will receive a certification operator card.



OSHA Aerial Lift Training pursuant to OSHA

29CFR1926.453: Only trained and authorized persons are allowed to operate an aerial lift. Training should include:

- Explanations of electrical, fall, and falling object hazards;
- Procedures for dealing with hazards;
- Recognizing and avoiding unsafe conditions in the work setting;
- Instructions for correct operation of the lift (including maximum intended load and load capacity);
- Demonstrations of the skills and knowledge needed to operate an aerial lift before operating it on the job;
- When and how to perform inspections; and
- Manufacturer's requirements. Fact Sheet Aerial Lifts
- Drop-offs, holes, or unstable surfaces such as loose dirt;
- Inadequate ceiling heights;
- Slopes, ditches, or bumps;
- Debris and floor obstructions;
- Overhead electric power lines and communication cables;
- Other overhead obstructions;
- Other hazardous locations and atmospheres;
- High wind and other severe weather conditions, such as ice; and
- The presence of others in close proximity to the work.

Attendees will be required to wear a harness. If you have your own harness, bring it for expediency.
